Privacy Policy

Your privacy is important to us and this Privacy Policy explains how we deal with the personal data obtained from entrants to the competition.

By entering the competition, you consent:

- To us processing your personal data for contacting purposes; and
- To us processing your personal data for internal administration purposes.

We may use your personal details to contact you with updates about the competition and about the Cambridge Autumn Festival in general.

Following judging, a list of prizewinning and highly commended entrants may be published in the “Cambridge News”, “Te Awamutu News”, on our website and our Facebook page.

Names and entry details may be used for promotional purposes without compensation. You consent to the use and disclosure of your details by entering the competition.

Only a limited number of Cambridge Autumn Festival trustees have access to your information. It is not provided to the competition judges.

Otherwise, we do not usually share personal information with third parties other than as follows:

- The competition sponsor who may contact you directly.
- We will refuse government and law enforcement requests for data if we believe a request is too broad or unrelated to its stated purpose. However, we may cooperate if we believe that the requested information is necessary and appropriate to comply with the legal process, to protect the safety of the public or any individual, to prevent a crime or to prevent what we reasonably believe to be an illegal or unethical activity.

We may change our Privacy Policy from time to time.
