Privacy Policy

Your privacy is important to us and this Privacy Policy explains how we deal with the personal data obtained from entrants to the competition.

By entering the competition, you consent:

- To us processing your personal data for contacting purposes; and
- To us processing your personal data for internal administration purposes.

We may use your personal details to contact you with updates about the competition and about the Cambridge Autumn Festival in general.

Following judging, a list of prize winners and their photos may be published in the "Cambridge News", "Te Awamutu News", on our website and our Facebook page.

Names and entry details may be used for promotional purposes without compensation. You consent to the use and disclosure of your details by entering the competition.

Only a limited number of Cambridge Autumn Festival trustees have access to your information. It is not provided to the competition judges.

The Cambridge Autumn Festival may wish, without compensation, to display the top entries at a photo exhibition during the Festival, and to display all the entries on their website. On the entry form, entrants indicate whether they agree to this.

If any competition photos are stand-out images to promote the district to visitors, the Cambridge isite may be interested in touching base with the photographers after the competition to seek permission for their use. The Cambridge Autumn Festival will contact these photographers to ask if they are happy for their contact details to be provided to the Cambridge isite.

Otherwise, we do not usually share personal information with third parties other than as follows: we will refuse government and law enforcement requests for data if we believe a request is too broad or unrelated to its stated purpose. However, we may cooperate if we believe that the requested information is necessary and appropriate to comply with the legal process, to protect the safety of the public or any individual, to prevent a crime or to prevent what we reasonably believe to be an illegal or unethical activity.
